PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Sikaflex®-545 is a one-component elastic assembly adhesive based on Sika Silane Terminated Polymer (STP) technology. It is a high initial grab adhesive and meets most severe EHS standards with very low emissions as it is free of isocyanate, solvent, PVC and phthalate. It can be applied easily by a manual dispenser. Nevertheless the high green strength of Sikaflex®-545 allows a powerful initial load capacity directly after application, outperforming most available silane modified products.

Sikaflex®-545 adheres well to a wide variety of substrates without the need for special pre-treatments. It can be used on substrates such as timber, glass, metals, metal primers and paint coatings (2-part systems), ceramic materials and plastics.

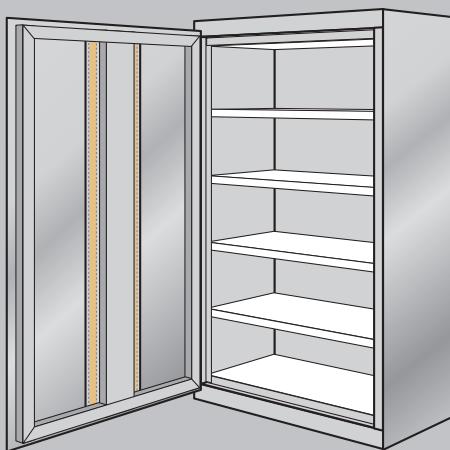

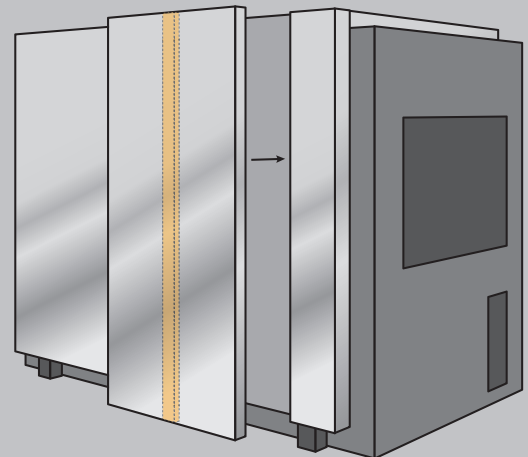
